Actors of Dionysus Artistic Director Tamsin Shasha will be starting a 3-week run at London's Riverside Studios, Oct 21st - Nov 8th at 8pm, performing in Theatralia's *Misterioso: A Journey into the Silence of Thelonius Monk* ('A crime to miss it' *The Times*).

Set in 1950s New York in a jazz club hosted by Monk's close friend, the Jazz Baroness, Pannonica Rothschild (Tamsin Shasha), *Misterioso* explores a time when black jazz musicians struggled not only to establish their own brand of new, passionate music but also against racist culture.
